1995 DUVAL LEROY 'FEMME' \$198

Carol Duval is the latest in an impressive list of widows who have revitalised their families' Champagne houses. The presentation of the 1995 "Femme" is stunning – if anything, the champagne is classier. It's gently perfumed, delicate and fine with persistent yeasty flavours, generous creamy texture and refreshing cleansing acidity.



2005 SHAW & SMITH 'M3 VINEYARD' CHARDONNAY \$38

This Adelaide Hills single-vineyard superstar has neatly slotted into the top bracket of Australian chardonnays: elegant, tight and fine with gentle cedary notes, intense white peach and nectarine flavours, balanced by a touch of minerality, before a fine zesty finish.



2004 SCORPO PINOT NOIR \$38

Made by Sandro Moselle for the Scorpo family, this Mornington pinot from Victoria is one of the top performers that show how well the variety can do on the Peninsula. It's intriguingly spicy, with dark berry and black cherry flavours, lush, sensuous texture and a refined classy finish that lingers.
