Made from the best Mornington pinot fermented in French oak barriques, this lush, scrumptious rosé is miles ahead of the current crop of sweet and sour cabernet jobbies. It oozes roses and raspberry, with that unique cashew nuttiness that comes from the marriage of pinot and good oak. Its juicy middle tapers off neatly to a long finish of extremely fine, dry tannins, ideal for lighter Mediterranean grills and salads.

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
